Sophie (IT Programmer, care giver, introvert) and Jonah (raised on a religious commune in Yorkshire – OCD and socially inept) plus a mangey old fox, called Scruffilitis

Whilst charming and delightful, the play is equally disturbing and intriguing, and has you wondering if it weren't for the 'love' would this be a psychological thriller?
